Happy New Year! I hope that everyone has enjoyed the Christmas break and is preparing for the new year. Employees return to school on January 4th and 5th. Students have an e-Learning day on January 5 and return to traditional school on January 6, 2021.

The COVID-19 health status for our area is still high and we will continue to follow ADPH and ALSDE guidelines. Over the holidays 36 Elmore County employees reported testing positive for COVID-19 and 8 students. We encourage all parents to notify their student's administration of any positive COVID-19 tests that occurred over the holidays. This will allow the local school administration to document and update student numbers accurately with the ADPH website. This has been a challenging first semester, and as second semester begins we will continue to monitor the health status of each school and communicate necessary changes, if any, prior to January 6.
