The GHS Sports Boosters met on August 16, 2018. - 1) Election of Officers for 2018-19. Per Jim Shaver, all current officers are willing to serve again expect for Vice-President. Jim opened up nominations. Motion made by Dan Freeman to accept current officers for another year; 2nd by Jay Kyzar. All Approved.

Nomination of Barry Jones for Vice-President made by Jeffery Warrick. 2nd by Bart Snyder. All Approved.

- 2) President Jim Shaver reminded everyone that we are wrapping up ad sales for the football program and asked everyone to turn in ads by Monday, Aug 20.
- 3) Motion made by Stephanie Snyder to ask the JV Cheerleaders to sell the football programs again this year at home football games. Cost will remain \$5 per program & we will give the cheerleaders \$2.50 for every program sold. 2nd by Kristie Freeman. All Approved
- 4) Stephanie Snyder expressed the need for a concession stand clean up date. Date set for Tuesday, August 21 at 6:00pm. Reminders will be sent out.
- 5) Stephanie Snyder presented information from Pepsi on the cost of drinks. Price for bottles going down this year from \$23.90 a case to \$17.50 a case. We can also purchase a pallet of water (48 cases) that drops the cost of water from \$6.00 a case to \$4.50 a case. Motion made by Stephanie Snyder to buy the pallet of water. 2nd by Kristie Freeman. All Approved.
- 6) Proposal submitted by Paige Gray to provide pizza for the JV football games. Prior years we have bought pizza from Little Caesar's. Discussion followed on pros/cons and a nomination was made by Jay Kyzar to accept Paige's proposal. 2nd by Barry Jones. All approved.
- 7) Coach Snyder brought up the topic of CPR certification for the coaches. All coaches are being trained on CPR on 8/17/18 by Jacob Fannin. The cost is \$30 per coach. Coach Snyder asked that the Booster Club cover the cost. Dr Bazzell is requiring that all coaches be re-certified every year. Motion made by Barry Jones to pay for this. 2nd by Jeffery Warrick. All approved.
- 8) Coach Snyder brought up the topic of Sideline Apparel for the coaches. He said that he would order the shirts/caps for all Male coaches & Coach Warrick would order for all

Female Coaches. Asked for a combined budget of \$2000. Motion made by April Brown and 2nd by Jeffery Warrick. All Approved.

- 9) Coach Snyder asked that the Booster Club pay for the HUDL subscription for the online video software. This product was used by football, volleyball, boys & girls basketball last year. Cost is \$800 for football and \$400 for each remaining sport. Motion made by April Brown, 2nd by Dan Freeman and All Approved.
- 10) Stephanie Snyder brought up the topic that the Booster Club had bought Senior posters for the last 2 years. This is something the kids look forward too. Does the Booster Club plan to pay for that again this year? Coach Warrick & Coach Snyder said they would decrease the “special award” purchased for the Seniors for the Spring Banquet if we could keep doing the posters and let this be their gift. Motion made to purchase the Senior posters by Dan Freeman and 2nd by Jessica Jones. All Approved.
- 11) Deer Hunt – Jim Shaver made the motion to appoint Jeffery Warrick as the chairman of the Deer Hunt. 2nd by Bart Snyder. All approved. The Deer Hunt is scheduled for January 11-13, 2019. A subcommittee of Jeffery Warrick, Jim Shaver and Jay Kyzar was formed to start the pre-planning for the hunt.
- 12) Christy Danner brought up the topic about feeding the band after halftime. There has been a complaint that there is not enough food (hamburgers/hotdogs) left when they get done playing after halftime. Everyone was in agreement that it is ok to put them some food back.
- 13) Christy Danner asked if the Booster Club would be selling fried turkeys this year. Dan Freeman made the motion that we NOT sell turkeys and the motion was 2nd by Bart Snyder. Christy asked if the band could use the turkey fryers for a fundraiser. Jim Shaver asked if we could discuss at a future meeting.
