## Termination of Asynchronous Remote Learning

- Students must meet the necessary requirements for attendance and progress, or they will be required to return to face to face instruction.
- Students and Parents will be notified by mail when they must return to face-to-face instruction.
- Students who have not met attendance requirements will be required to make up attendance or risk the possibility of receiving no credit and retention.
- Students with special circumstance due to health related issues for the student or live in relative who live in the same household will be evaluated case by case.
- A note from the doctor stating specific reasons for students to remain remote asynchronous will be accepted as cause for continuing remote learning.
- Parents who feel their child should remain on remote learning can appeal the termination of remote learning by meeting with Principal within 14 days of date on revocation notice. A committee will review the request and determine outcome.
- Students who return to face to face instruction from remote learning will receive a grace period of no longer than two weeks to acclimate back to the school schedule and on campus learning.
