

## **SUMMARY FOR NOVEMBER 5, 2020 MEETING**

The Coosa County Board of Education met today by teleconference via Google Meet, with members of the public allowed to listen in, under the authority granted by Governor Ivey in Section III of her emergency Proclamation of March 18, 2020. A quorum was present. The Board of Education also deliberated and passed on 4 to 0 votes motions to accomplish the following essential minimum functions for the school district, all on the recommendation of the Superintendent:

- To adopt a Prohibition on Aiding and Abetting Sexual Abuse policy;
- To grant permission to auction two surplus vehicles on GovDeals;
- To approve Resolution Regarding Indemnity;
- To approve job descriptions for administrative, certified and support personnel;
- To accept three resignations;
- To hire one bus driver, one substitute teacher/aide, and two substitute bus drivers;
- To approve three contracts: for behavior specialist services, for behavior analyst services, and for sign language interpreting services;
- To approve one volunteer coach;
- To accept grant for purchase of CNP van;
- To approve re-opening plan with blended approach to include in-person and virtual instruction;
- To approve bills paid for September 2020; and
- To pass resolutions concerning the incoming and outgoing superintendents.

Our annual meeting will be Thursday, November 19, 2020. Board members David Tuck, Randall Hardman and Donna McVey were recognized for years of service.
