Return to Face-to-Face Instruction

Take In and Dismissal

When students arrive, they will report directly to their homeroom/assigned classes starting at 7:15 AM. When students are dismissed at 2:20, buses will run their regular schedule. Elementary bus students will be called when their bus arrives in the rear of the school. Elementary car riders will be picked up on the elementary side and middle school car riders will be picked up in the rear of the school after busses have left. Walkers will be called to dismiss.

Breakfast and Lunch

Breakfast will be served from 7:15 AM- 7:30 AM. Lunch will be served in the classroom during your scheduled lunch times. Remote learners will be able to pick up their meals on Mondays from 9 AM-1 PM.

Uniforms

Uniforms are required every day, along with face covering. Please refer to the Chastang-Fournier K-8 School Uniform Policy.

Laptops and Supplies

Students will need the following supplies: Laptop, Charger, and Wired earbuds (no Bluetooth), Carrying Case, and bottled water

Parents are asked to check temperatures and to carefully screen their students for illness each day before sending them to school.

Chastang-Fournier K-8 has designated entrances for each grade level. Kindergarten through 5th grade will enter and exit on the elementary end of the building. 6th grade will enter and exit the building through the cafeteria. 7th grade will enter and exit through the middle doors between the cafeteria and gym, and 8th grade will enter and exit through the gym.

CAN WE CHANGE OUR MIND ABOUT RETURNING OR REMOTE LEARNING? HOW LONG WILL REMOTE LEARNING CONTINUE? Unless a child must quarantine, necessitating the use of remote learning, all students will be allowed to change their decision ONLY once. The Superintendent will decide after first quarter whether to continue offering remote learning.
