

Prague Public School's Safe Return Plan

Goals of the District for the upcoming school Year:

- Health and safety of all students and staff
- Learning gap reduction
- Social and mental health needs of all students and staff
- Equal opportunities to learn
- Ensure continuity of services to address students' academic needs, students and staff members' social, emotional needs, mental health needs, physical health needs and nutrition needs.

Health and Safety Procedure Components:

- Masks optional. (See below for universal and correct way to wear masks)
- Classrooms spaced out as far as possible.
- Common areas set apart as far as the space will accommodate.
- Cleaning done every day and deep cleaning once a week.
- Hand sanitizer on school buses, windows open when possible.
- Hand sanitizer in classrooms.
- Hand sanitizer available in the halls.
- Hand-washing and respiratory etiquette signs posted in common areas and restrooms of each building
- Updating and adding additional ventilation as needed, may include adding new AC/Heating units.
- Use of the State Infection Reporting System on Single Sign On for contact tracing, isolation and quarantine reporting.
- In accordance with recent changes published by the CDC and OCCHD, Prague Public Schools will follow the following policy regarding social distancing and quarantine:
 - Fully-vaccinated individuals who have been exposed to an infected individual do not need to quarantine unless they develop symptoms.
 - Fully-vaccinated is defined as 2 weeks after the second dose in a double-dose series or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine.
 - All other situations will follow State and Federal mandates for isolation and quarantine.
- Diagnostic and screening testing available through the school nurse, local hospital, and County Health Department.
- Will communicate local vaccinations opportunities to all staff and students via the school website.
- Appropriate accommodations will be given for children with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies.
- Will continue to communicate weekly with State and local health officials through email correspondence and media sites.

Universal/correct wearing of masks: Guidance for those who choose to wear a mask:

- Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer before putting on your mask.
- Put the mask over your nose and mouth and secure it under your chin.
- Fit the mask snugly against the sides of your face, slipping the loops over your ears or tying the strings behind your head.
- If you have to continually adjust your mask, it doesn't fit properly, and you might need to find a different mask type or brand.

Return to School in the Fall

- School will begin on August 12, 2021. Two options will be available: 1) Traditional/face to face format 2) Virtual/Blended Learning format.
- All classes and activities resume at regular school times at regularly assigned sites.
- Blended Learning will be hosted in the High School Library.
- Additional Health and Safety measures at each site (see above).
- All students grades 3-12 will have their own electronic device (high school and virtual students can take those home if proper paperwork is on file) (Some devices will be classroom sets) (Grades K4-1 will have access to a device as needed.)

Virtual Learning/Blended: Done through the local virtual academy

- School Issued Device (Internet provided as needed).
- Each student will have access to the Virtual Academy Director through email or appointment.
- Attendance required. The director/teacher will record attendance daily based upon student completing all of their activities and hours.
- At least 2 grades will be recorded per week and will be graded based on traditional grading scales. Students must complete assigned work or a zero will be recorded.
- High School Students must meet all graduation requirements.
- Students will be issued school email addresses to use and be granted access to an online program such as FuelEd, Edgenuity, Odysseyware, etc.
