

## **700.2L DISPOSITION OF TROPHIES**

### **I. PURPOSE**

With the significant number of trophies available and earned each year, the district needs a plan to deal with the storage or disposition of same.

### **II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY**

#### **A. Trophies to remain indefinitely:**

Trophies earned from varsity competition under the following categories will be permanently displayed in the school trophy cases:

1. Conference Champions
2. District or Sub-Section awards
3. Region/Section awards
4. State awards
5. Pre 1960 trophies

#### **B. Trophies to be removed:**

Trophies earned from varsity and non-varsity competition that do not fall into these categories will be displayed in the trophy cases until the participants who earned the awards have graduated. These trophies will then be removed and placed in storage until the next All School Reunion (approximately every 5 years). At this time they will be placed on the All School Reunion auction and will be auctioned to the highest bidder or sold in a silent auction.

#### **C. Auditorium:**

The two trophy cases on the west lobby wall will be used for historical displays. The west center display cases will be used for marquee information. The east media area cases will be used for elementary displays. The four tall display cases will be used for fine arts trophies and displays.

#### **D. Sports Center foyer:**

The trophy cases in the Sports Center foyer will be used for athletic trophies and displays.

#### **E. Hallway trophies:**

The hallway trophy cases will be used as per donor request if preapproved by the district.
