

## **Definitions for Early Childhood Outcomes Summary (ECOS) Ratings**

7	<ul> <li>Child shows functioning expected for his or her age in all or almost all everyday situations that are part of the child's life.</li> <li>No one on the team has concerns about the child's functioning in</li> </ul>
	this outcome area.
6	<ul> <li>Child's functioning generally is considered appropriate for his or her age, but there are some significant concerns about the child's functioning in this outcome area.</li> <li>Although age-appropriate, the child's functioning may border on</li> </ul>
	not keeping pace with age expectations.
5	<ul> <li>Child shows functioning expected for his or her age some of the time and/or in some settings and situations.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Child's functioning is a mix of age-expected and not age-expected behaviors and skills.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Child's functioning might be described as like that of a slightly younger child.</li> </ul>
ted 4	<ul> <li>Child shows occasional age-appropriate functioning across settings and situations.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>More functioning is not age-expected than age-expected.</li> </ul>
Overall Not Age-Expected	<ul> <li>Child does not yet show functioning expected of a child of his or her age in any situation.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Child uses immediate foundational skills most or all of the time across settings and situations.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Functioning might be described as like that of a younger child.</li> </ul>
2	<ul> <li>Child occasionally uses immediate foundational skills across settings and situations.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>More functioning reflects skills that are not immediate foundational than are immediate foundational.</li> </ul>
1	<ul> <li>Child does not yet show functioning expected of a child his or her age in any situation.</li> </ul>
	Child's functioning does not yet include immediate foundational
	skills upon which to build age-appropriate functioning.
	<ul> <li>Child's functioning might be described as like that of a much younger child.</li> </ul>
