

This district shall follow all current and subsequent eligibility requirements as set forth by the Idaho High School Activities Association. All students wishing to participate in extra-curricular activities must meet the eligibility requirements.

Student participants in all extra-curricular activities, including athletics, of this district shall uphold and comply with the training policies which are designed to allow the maximum benefit from participation in the extracurricular activities.

Parents and/or guardians should understand that with any physical activity, there is an element of risk, including severe injury and even paralysis or death associated with participation. Stringent efforts will be made by the district to prevent or minimize injuries, but students participate in athletics at their own risk.

Student participation in all extra-curricular activities must comply with the Drug and Alcohol Testing of students participating in Extracurricular Activities Policy #578.

Students who participate in extra-curricular activities must be in compliance with school policy as well as policies set forth by the Idaho High School Activities Association.

These policies include:

1. Students must pass the appropriate number of classes based on the following criteria:

i. 5 classes available	must pass at least four
ii. 6 classes available	must pass at least five
iii. 7 classes available	must pass at least five
2. Students participating in athletics must have a physical exam prior to practicing or participating, insurance, and an activity card from the appropriate school.
3. Participants must be in four classes (on the trimester schedule) to be eligible to practice or participate in a competitive event of the activity that day unless excused by the athletic director, or the advisor, and the principal.
4. Participants who miss practice without being excused by the coach before practice may not participate in the next competitive event. Excessive unexcused missed practices may result in dismissal from the squad.
5. Participants who are truant from school or class on the day of a competitive activity may not participate in the activity. Participants who have more than one truancy may be dismissed from the squad.

6. Participants who have been suspended from school may not participate in a competitive activity during the suspension.
  - a. A second suspension from school may result in multiple game suspensions or dismissal from the squad. A probationary status will follow the participant into the next sport season or until the end of the school year.
  - b. A third suspension from school will result in the automatic suspension from the squad, and forfeiting the right to represent the school in the next athletic season or until the end of the school year.
7. Participants must ride the transportation provided by the district unless the coach or advisor speaks directly to the parent, and the parent will provide the transportation.
8. Participants who have been denied credit due to attendance must have for (4) passing grades in other subjects. If the participant does not have four passing grades, he or she will not be eligible to participate during the next trimester.
