

WEATHER GUIDELINES FOR OUTDOOR PLAY

Deciding when students may play outdoors is the responsibility of the Principal or designee, based on his/her professional judgment. Principals should communicate with the community that it is the intention of the school to hold outdoor activities throughout the school year and that parents should ensure their children are prepared with appropriate seasonal attire.

If a child is not properly attired for the weather conditions, they will remain inside.

Below is a general guideline for outdoor activities during cold/hot weather.

Winter Weather

Temperature /Wind Chill:

Above 20 degrees
0-20 degrees
Below 0

Outdoor Timeframe

Regularly scheduled outdoor activities
15 minutes
No outdoor activities

Summer Weather

Temperature/Heat Index:

Below 90 degrees
90-95 degrees
Above 95 degrees

Outdoor Timeframe:

Regularly scheduled outdoor activities
15-20 minutes
No outdoor activities
