## Open Registration for all NEW 2021-2022 Preschool and Kindergarten Students

Child **MUST** turn **3** years of age or **4** years of age on or before October 1, 2021 for Preschool **OR** turn **5** years of age on or before October 1, 2021 for Kindergarten.

**\*If your child is already attending our Preschool you DO NOT have to register again.**

**OPEN REGISTRATION begins the week of March 15, 2021 and will remain open for Preschool students until classes are FULL. At that time a WAITLIST will begin for all future registrations. Kindergarten classes DO NOT have a limit.**

The following documents are **REQUIRED** for registration:

1. Child's Original Birth Certificate (Must be State copy - **NOT** Hospital copy)
2. Child's Current Immunization Records & Physical
3. Proof of Residency
4. Custody Documents (if applicable)

### **PROOF OF RESIDENCY REQUESTED ITEMS**

**HOMEOWNER:** Deed or most recent tax bill from the City of Brigantine

**RENTERS:** A Lease or notarized letter from the landlord listing **ALL** occupants, or other evidence of residency and any 2 items from the following list:

- Paystub with name and address
- Utility bills - Gas, Electric or Home Phone Only
- Voter Registration Card
- Financial account information containing home address
- Other documentation will be considered

### **RESIDENTS SHARING QUARTERS: (PLEASE PROVIDE ALL ITEMS)**

1. Owner's deed or most recent tax bill from the City of Brigantine
2. Notarized letter from the owner listing **ALL** occupants
3. Proof of address for the parent (Paycheck Stub, Utility Bill, etc.)

**(ALL THREE DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED FOR SHARED QUARTERS)**

**REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE WITHOUT ALL NECESSARY PAPERWORK.**

Parents who suspect that their Preschool age child may have special needs can get free help from their local school District's Child Study Team. Brigantine Public School District's Child Find Campaign locates and provides services for those children ages 3 to 5 who may have physical, mental, language or emotional difficulties.
