5TH GRADE ART LESSON WEEK 2

In this lesson you will learn how to cord weave. Cord weaving is useful for many things such as straps and bracelets. I wear a cord bracelet on my left wrist you may have seen it before. It's a very strong weave.

Supplies:

Cardboard

Scissors

Pencil or marker

Circle tracer (like yogurt top)

8 strings of fiber (thread or yarn or embroidery floss or anything you have on hand you could use old shoelaces!)
