PHEAA and FAFSA – Important dates for High School Seniors:

- October 1, 2020** The 2021-2022 *FAFSA* can be completed on or after this date. File electronically at FAFSA.gov.
- May 1, 2021** The 2021-2022 *FAFSA* filing deadline for the Pennsylvania State Grant Program for all new applicants who plan to enroll in baccalaureate degree programs.
- August 1, 2021** The 2021-2022 *FAFSA* filing deadline for the Pennsylvania State Grant Program for all new applicants who plan to enroll in designated Pennsylvania Open Admission institutions: business, trade and technical schools; hospital school of nursing; or two-year non-transferable career programs at two-year public, junior or four-year colleges.
