2020 Graduating Senior Scholarship Requirements & Procedures

1. Description

Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative (TWEC) will award up to six (6) \$1,000 scholarships to 2020 graduating high school seniors for their first year as a (freshman) college student.

2. Criteria

- Complete and sign the application.
- Be a graduating high school senior entering your freshmen year of college in the fall of 2020.
- Applicant's parents or legal guardians must be a Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative member whose primary residence receives electricity from TWEC.
- Average GPA of at least 2.0 or better during grade 9 through first half of grade 12.
- Be accepted by an accredited two or fouryear college/university, or a vocationaltechnical school.
- Involved in 4 different extra-curricular activities (school, employment, community), during high school. List each activity only once, regardless of the number of years involved.
- A transcript from your high school signed by a school official.
- One letter of recommendation from an educator or local community leader.

3. Award Procedure

- Applications will be reviewed by a qualified review committee.
- Winners will be notified in April of 2020.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.
- The scholarship check will be mailed to the Financial Aid Office of the institution you will

- be attending. The check will be made out in the name of the scholarship recipient and the institution. The amount of the scholarship will be divided into two equal disbursements with \$350 disbursed in the first semester and \$350 in the second semester.
- Scholarship recipient must maintain at least a (2.0) average or better during their first semester in order to receive the second semester disbursement. Recipient must send verification to TWEC.
- Applicant must maintain a minimum college course load of 12 credits per term.
- If a recipient withdraws from school or elects to attend a non-accredited school after receiving a scholarship, the scholarship will be terminated and any refunds from the school will go to TWEC.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender, or disability. Children or grandchildren of current TWEC employees or directors are ineligible.

4. When to Apply

www.toddwadena.coop, and local high schools. Application and attachments should be submitted to: Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative, Attn: Scholarship Program, P.O. Box 431, Wadena, MN 56482 and must be postmarked on or by February 28, 2020.

Todd-Wadena Electric Cooperative (TWEC) reserves the right to terminate the scholarship program or change the provisions and conditions with reasonable notice except that: once a scholarship is awarded for a school year, it will continue throughout the expiration of the term.
