- * All teachers and students will have an extended lunch block as indicated in conjunction with 4th period.
- * Instruction is to be limited to the time frames indicated above and should **NOT** take place during the extended lunch time.
- * Students are allowed to use their cell phones in the classroom following the guidelines distributed to teachers and posted in the classroom.
- * Lunch time assignments are assigned by teacher pairs if the classroom is not assigned to eat in the cafeteria (assigned on the following tabs).
- * Class pairs are assigned to a specific lunch line (map attached) that will be the **ONLY** line used by those classes throughout the school year. Signs are posted at each line for reference.
- * All lunches will be grab-&-go style, with all lines serving the same lunches each day.
- * Some classes are required to remain in the cafeterias for students to eat for various reasons. Those classes have been assigned to specific cafeterias and report first to each lunch block. Teachers should rotate with their buddy delivering students to the cafeteria and remaining with them until the end of the assigned time on their respective tab.
- * If no cafeteria assignment is listed for the class pairs, students should return to the classroom to eat their lunch.
- * Teachers are assigned as "buddies" in order to allow one teacher to escort cafeteria students and the other to monitor students remaining in both classes.
- * Teachers of <u>ODD</u> numbered classrooms will escort students to the cafeteria on Monday/Wednesday and teachers of <u>EVEN</u> numbered classrooms will escort students on Tuesday/Thursday. Teacher pairs should rotate escorting students on Fridays. Classrooms not fitting this system will work out their own schedule.
- * Substitute teachers will not be responsible for escorting cafeteria students. If both teachers in a pair have a substitute present, a cafeteria escort will be assigned to the students.
- * Students wanting to retrieve food/drink from the vending machines may travel with the cafeteria group to the vending area, retrieve their snack and drink, and wait for their cafeteria group to return to class all together. Please encourage students to use hand sanitizer before and after use of the vending machines. These machines **WILL NOT** be available during other times of the day.
- * Students must leave for lunch at their exact assigned time and return as quickly as lunch is received by the entire group in order to minimize group contact.
- * Students who bring their lunch from home or choose not to eat should remain in the classroom to be monitored from the hallway by the teacher reamining behind.
- * Teachers who escort students to the cafeteria should ensure they maintain social distancing while travelling and waiting in line. Teachers should gather students as a group and wait for all to retrieve lunch. They should all travel back to the classroom, socially distancing in a group.
- * When all cafeteria-bound students have returned to the classrooms, teacher "buddies" can work out monitoring their class pairs and taking care of their personal lunches and business between themselves.
