			are approved by school principals for K-8 and	
			Mr. Smith approves others. She asked how this	
			would be policed.

- Mrs. McInerney said the regulations will clarify the issues like the PTO question.
- Mrs. Faulenbach said she looked at this differently as the past practice for sending flyers out has a different policy. She said this came about as a result of the costs of the turf field and how to pay for it. She said the Board does need to be careful about how they go about this though. She said she was going to look at other districts too.
- Mr. Schemm said they can look into CABE too.
- Mrs. Faulenbach felt this leaves the Superintendent with a lot of discretion.
- Mr. Schemm said he felt there was good, open language.
- Mrs. McInerney asked if fundraising would be the responsibility of the turf committee as they introduce a buy a brick program.
- Mrs. Faulenbach said they are looking into various fundraising programs.
- Mr. Schemm said Policy 1140 deals with the distribution of materials.
- Mrs. Faulenbach said many policies feed off of each other. She also suggested reaching out to CABE for assistance on this policy.
- Mr. Smith noted several other districts have turf fields now too, such as New Fairfield and Ridgefield. He said he would have the athletic director reach out to them to see if they have policies.
- Mr. Schemm said in relation to this policy there would be no July 4<sup>th</sup> meeting and so the samples would have to be brought to the August meeting for consideration.
- Mrs. McInerney asked if this would go before Facilities and Mrs. Faulenbach said Kevin Munrett is on the turf field committee as are parents and students.

- Mr. Smith said this is slotted for a full vote by the Board on July 18<sup>th</sup>. Mrs. Faulenbach asked how this would get into the handbook and Mr. Smith said it would be in the elementary schools actual handbook but would be an addendum piece to the high school.
- Mrs. Faulenbach asked if parents would still sign off on this and Mr. Smith said they would get this as part of the overall school packet as one of the forms. It will also be part of the portal which will be introduced by a splash page to get attention.
- Mr. Dahl asked what would happen if someone did not have a computer and Mr. Smith said parents still get this information in writing.
- Mrs. McInerney said there is no parent portal for K-5 and Mr. Smith said the packet goes home with the kids but the portal will be available next year.
- Mr. Schemm noted on Appendix B that the agreement is unbounded and asked what would happen if things change. Mr. Smith said the attorney said keep it unbounded but the intent is for it to be signed each year.
- Mrs. Faulenbach felt parents need to be made to understand that they have some responsibility on this issue. Mr. Smith said they do try to educate parents at open houses and curriculum nights but the turnout is often light. This needs to be a partnership between parents and children and the schools.
- Mrs. Faulenbach suggested a cover letter be added which states that this needs to be discussed in the house.
- Mr. Smith said the school system has resources to manage technology and to have a conversation with their children.
- Mrs. McInerney asked how the school district can say someone can't legally post an opinion.

He said a summative report would say "at or above" versus 4.2 for instance.</li> <li>Mrs. Faulenbach said this has too much resolution.
