



Intention to Participate in the ISAAC Remote Learning Academy

According to the *ISAAC Reopening Guide* and the Connecticut State Department of Education's mandate to allow the option for families to choose a remote option to attend school, ISAAC Families who choose to have your student(s) temporarily participate in the ISAAC Remote Learning Academy due to COVID-19, must complete this form and return it via email by August 7, 2020.

Families electing to begin the ISAAC Remote Learning Academy due to COVID-19 will be contacted by School Administration or the Student Support Coordinator to discuss their student's educational plan. Any student enrolled in the ISAAC Remote Learning Academy can return to the classroom upon communication with the school and a planning meeting is held prior to placement into a grade-level cohort. In addition, it is not guaranteed that the student's electives will remain the same when entering into a specific cohort. Moreover, the move back to in-person is intended to be a permanent move for they cannot remotely learn some days and come to school in-person on other days.

Families electing the ISAAC Remote Learning Academy understand the following:

- The ISAAC Remote Learning Academy is intended to be a temporary situation for COVID-19 reasons
- Students must participate daily in their education remotely and check-in for daily attendance
- All lessons are developed by certified teachers utilizing the established curriculum
- Students are required to complete work and assessments just as if they were attending in person
- Students must participate in our full academic program with hard work, maximum effort, and grit
- Students will follow a schedule and grading structure similar to their peers engaging in Daily In-Person Instruction Model (Plan A) or the Hybrid Instruction Model (Plan B)
- All classes will use instructional materials available electronically throughout the remote experience
- Learning opportunities will include recorded asynchronous video instruction available to students throughout the day/week and live office hour sessions and supports
- All core classes (mathematics, ELA, SS, science) will provide asynchronous videos (up to 25 minutes) along with an assignment multiple times a week
- Teachers will provide live office hours multiple times per week at designated times via ZOOM
- Students can request individual support throughout the Remote Learning Program via ZOOM or phone
- All elective classes will provide asynchronous videos (up to 10-15 minutes) along with an assignment designed to complete in less time than a core assignment
- Students will experience social and emotional support through our advisory model remotely with other ISAAC students who have chosen the Remote Learning Academy
- All students will receive appropriate support and services to the greatest extent possible through the general education program, Student Intervention plans (SRBI), Individualized Educational plans (Special Education IEPs), 504 plans, and English Learners plans (EL)

Completion of this form indicates that my student will temporarily participate in the ISAAC Remote Learning Program for the start of the 2020-2021 school year. If applicable, I understand that I must communicate with the school for a re-entry meeting prior to my student attending ISAAC in-person.

Families with multiple families must complete a form for each student who will be enrolled in the Remote Learning Academy at the beginning of the school year.
