All students and parents receive copies of the *Code of Student Conduct,* which describes disciplinary offenses and how the school district handles them. Parents are responsible for ensuring that their children adhere to the rules and conventions of proper behavior while at school. SCCSD has an official policy of "zero tolerance" for student behavior that could disrupt instruction or pose safety hazards on SCCSD property and at school-related events. Such behavior includes the possession of weapons, drugs, or alcohol.
