July 19, 2004

The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, July 19, 2004, at 5 p.m. in Board Room B at the Central Office.

Call to Order

Chairperson LaVerne Williams called the meeting to order. Board members in attendance were as follows: P. Guthrie, A. Lanier, T. McDonald, G. Lawson, and B. Coltrane. Barry Scott was not present for the meeting

The Board observed a Moment of Silence before beginning the meeting.

Chairperson LaVerne Williams led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes

G. Lawson made a motion seconded B. Coltrane that minutes of the meetings held on June 21 and July 8, 2004, be approved as presented. The motion carried: 6-0.

Adoption of Agenda

P. Guthrie made a motion seconded by T. McDonald that the Board adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried: 6-0.

Consent Items

B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by T. McDonald that the Board approve consent items as presented:

Tuition Rates – \$1,051.18 For students living out-of-county and attending a school located in the Archdale-Trinity Special Tax District; \$736.49 For students living out-of-county and attending a Randolph County Schools located outside of the Archdale-Trinity Special Tax District; and \$314.69 For students living in the county, but outside the Archdale-Trinity Special District, attending a school located in the Archdale-Trinity Special Tax District.
3. Child Nutrition Vendors – U.S. Foods (Meats and General Groceries) and Pet Dairy (Milk and Ice Cream).
4. Second Reading of Policies 3620-R1 and R2, 4300, 4360, 5015, and 5070.
5. First Reading of Policy – 7505 Duty Free Period.
6. Change in School Depository – Move Liberty School Cafeteria Account from Fidelity Bank to Randolph Bank.

AYP Results

Vicki Moss reported that five schools on the watch list had met their AYP goals. Randolph County will have no schools of choice next year. No schools have been placed on the watch list for the coming school year. Twenty-three out of 28 schools made AYP. As a district, we met 57 of 61 goals.

Budget Update

Superintendent McRae expressed appreciation to parents, the community, employees and County Commissioners for their support for local funding for the system for the 2004-2005 school year. He reported that the system would face some challenges, with a cut in state funding expected. A final budget with local, state, and federal funds will be presented to the Board in August.
