**LOCATION:** Perry High is located in Perry, Georgia approximately 30 miles south of Macon, Georgia. PHS has an approximate enrollment of 1350 students and serves the needs of a growing community of 15,000.

**SCHOOL:** Perry High School is a comprehensive high school offering CTAE, special education, AP, gifted, and college preparatory courses. Twenty-four credits are required for graduation: 4 English, 4 Math, 4 Science, 3 Social Studies, ½ Health, ½ Personal Fitness, and 5 general credits.

**GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAM:** Perry High offers honors and AP courses to meet the needs of high achieving students. Honors courses have three quality points added to the student's final average and AP courses have five quality points added to the student's final average. These courses include:

**CLASS RANK:** All students are ranked based on numerical grades divided by the number of classes taken. The GPA associated with class rank is cumulative and includes both required and elective courses. Quality points for Honors (3 points) and AP classes (5 points) are included in the class rank and GPA. Grades earned in AP and Honors courses may exceed 100 points.
