# YELLOW LINES






❖ \_\_\_\_\_ painted on

# WHITE ARROW






❖. \_\_\_\_\_ at the left of your

# SOLID LINE






\_\_\_\_\_ separate traffic traveling  
in the same direction.

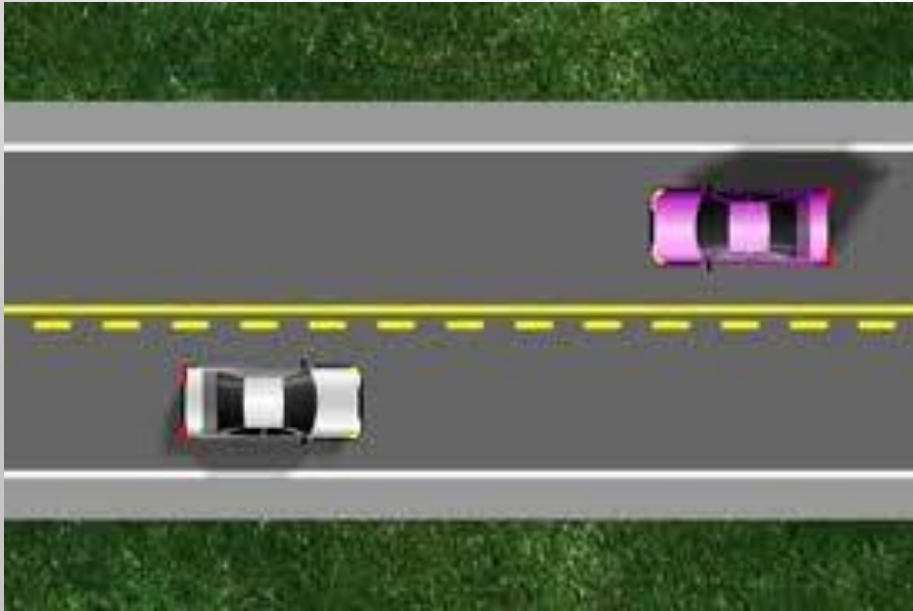
# WHITE LINES

❖ \_\_\_\_\_ colored signs lead you to services such as telephone, gas, motels etc.



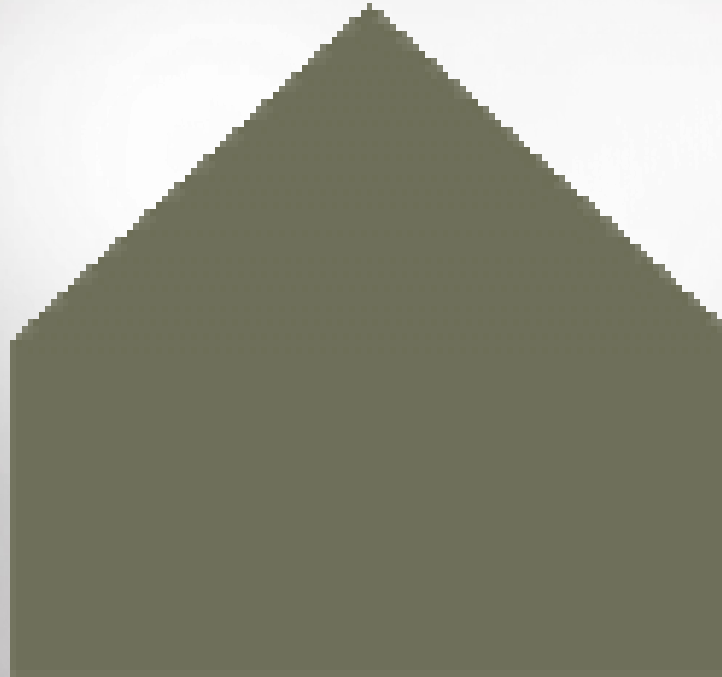





manner




# STEADY DOWNWARD YELLOW ARROW



- 
- ❖ Crosswalk is marked by two parallel lines painted white .
  - ❖ However crosswalks at intersections are not always marked . If there is no stop line , stop at the crosswalk, marked or not marked.
  - ❖ If there is no crosswalk stop at the edge of the sidewalk.
  - ❖ If there is no sidewalk stop at the edge of the intersection.

# CROSSWALK WHITE






❖ Pavement markings work with road signs and traffic lights to give you important information about the direction of traffic and where you may and may not travel.
