CCHS AFJROTC “Varsity Letter” Award

Cadets of KY-951 have the opportunity to earn a “**Letter**” in JROTC, just like other programs (athletics, etc.) a specific CCHS AFJROTC jacket was designed for this program. The jacket is available for purchase once a cadet has established themselves as a viable cadet in the program. This usually happens after the first semester of “**Year 1**” in the program. Proving to the instructors that they have conformed to additional requirements of the AFJROTC program. The actual “**Letter**” will be awarded at the “End of the Year Banquet” held in April of each school year. Requirements to earn this prestigious award are listed below:

- 1) Uniform Average of **90%** or Higher (2 yr. minimum)
- 2) Successfully lead 30-Step drill card with zero discrepancies
- 3) No Less than a “**B**” in JROTC (Report Card grades – 2 yr. minimum)
- 4) **3.0 GPA** for two years or more while in JROTC
- 5) Complete five or more “**Color Guard**” events
- 6) Participate in “**2 LDRs**” for a full season
- 7) Successful completion as “**Project Lead/POC**” for two **major** unit projects
- 8) Completed a semester in a Group Position (promoted a 9-week point) or
- 9) 2 semesters in Squadron CC position (promoted at 9-week point)
- 10) No “**Major**” Discipline Issues (**SASI Discretion**)
- 11) **250 Community Service Hours** or more

As with most “Letter” programs, it can take on average about three years to earn this award. Again, something that will be well deserved as you mold yourself into a community leader.
