## 2016-2017

- August-
  - \* Standard: Grammar. Editing, revising, verb tense and use
  - Standard: Genre. Exposure to a variety of genres and how they differ
    - > Objective: to develop better foundational writing skills, specifically targeted to English learners
    - > Objective: to introduce the idea and language of books/articles/texts and how they are categorized

- Major Project/Assignment: reading historical fiction
- September-
  - Standard: Word meanings. Determine the meanings of words as they are used in the text. Understand how to use the text to help discern word meanings.
  - Standard: Language. Understanding academic versus conversational English.
    - > Objective: Increase vocabulary
    - > Objective: Build academic vocabulary while supporting conversational English
      - ✓ Major Project/Assignment: vocabulary assessment

October-

- Standard: Grammar. Editing and the writing process.
- **\*** Standard: Reading. Understand how a writer develops a genre.
  - > Objective: Increase our ability to write.
  - > Objective: Learn the ways authors use tone, mood, word choice, etc to develop a theme/ genre.
    - ✓ Major Project/Assignment: compare and contrast media to literature

November-

- Standard: Speaking and Listening. Learning how to adapt speech to a variety of contexts and tasks.
- **\*** Standard: Reading. Finding the central idea of a text.
  - Objective: Explaining ideas, clarifying questions, restating points.
  - > Objective: Understand what a text is about.
    - Major Project/Assignment: Reading and presenting findings on a chosen topic

- December-
  - Standard: Reading. Using vocabulary and main idea to understand a text.
  - Standard: Grammar. Writing for a specific purpose, for example to inform, persuade, or entertain.
    - > Objective: Improve literacy skills
    - > Objective: Understand word choice when writing for a specific purpose
      - ✓ Major Project/Assignment:Review of the semester skills. End of term assessment.
- January-
  - Standard: Language. Correct word choice including connecting words, verbs, and precise language
  - Standard: Reading. Finding the central ideas and supporting details.
    - > Objective: Increase vocabulary and writing skills.
    - Objective: Increase understanding of a text and author's purpose.
      - ✓ Major Project/Assignment: Extended writing
- February-
  - **Standard: Writing. Introduce a topic and support your ideas.**
  - Standard: Language: Writing sentences that are complex or show sequence and structure.
    - > Objective: Learning to write more specifically to be understood.
    - > Objective: Increase vocabulary
      - ✓ Major Project/Assignment: Revision of extended writing project.

March-

 Standard: Reading. Learning how several elements combine to create a genre.

- Standard: Language. Vocabulary
  - > Objective: Increase literacy through in depth study of genre
  - > Objective: Increase vocabulary
    - ✓ Major Project/Assignment: Vocabulary assessment through reading text

- ✤ April-
  - Standard: Speaking and Listening. Oral stories and reporting. Creating a debate.
  - **\*** Standard: Language. The power of persuasive language.
    - > Objective: Develop better listening skills.
    - > Objective: Use language to convince or persuade a listener.
      - ✓ Major Project/Assignment: Create and present a debate as a team
- May-
  - **\*** Standard: Reading. Informational texts and current events.
  - Standard: Grammar. Review of skills
    - > Objective: Expose students to some additional types of texts and vocabulary while exploring current events.
    - > Objective: Reviewing grammar skills from the year
      - Major Project/Assignment: reporting on current events.
