- 5. New EIP (Early Intervention Program) Models for FY20
 - Self-contained (max 14 students)
 - Reduced all day or by the hour
 - Puli-Out
 - This has changed from the augmented model of the past.
 - Some EIP students are also served during AO (Academic Opportunity) Time using the LLI intensive reading instruction

6. New curriculum initiatives

- Second Step-Social and Emotional Lessons twice weekly in each class/primarily during SS
 - Plus Child Protective Lessons from the Counselor and Behavior/Anti-Bullying Lessons from the Assistant Principal
- STEAM (Science Technology Engineering And Math) Time-Once per week per class/primarily during Science on Fridays
 - i. Using the STEAM carts and tubs (maker space activities)
 - ii. PTO has purchased additional STEAM carts/and we are now have one desktop computer lab and three rolling laptop labs
- Phonics Units of Study-Lucy Calkins (Teachers College NY)
 - i. Piloted in each grade level last year
 - ii. Fully implemented in all classrooms K-2 this year with on-going training by the district an our EIP teacher/coach
 - iii. PTO assisted with buying additional "mascots" and materials for the phonics program
 - iv. LJPS purchased additional read aloud texts for each classroom to support the program
- MAPS testing K-2nd grade
 - i. Computer based test on foundation skills in math and reading
 - Scores are predictors of on-grade level progress and future GMAS scores

- 7. Current PLC (professional learning community) work for staff
 - Continued development of AO (Academic Opportunity) time lessons based on Essential
 Standards (2 sheets provided to parents at the beginning of the year: one to keep and one to sign and return for teachers to document progress on throughout the year)
 - Creating Common Formative Assessments to use across the entire grade per Essential Standard
 - Deconstructing the State Standards to form "I CAN" statements for students
 - i. Example- "I can draw and write a story." Based off Kindergarten Writing Standard
