Goal 2: Stakeholder engagement- continuing implementation of PBIS, 7 capacity building activities (ex Bright Night) and staff professional development.

Goal 3 : Continuous improvement by ensuring meaningful professional learning that increases personnel effectiveness and student achievement. Work as a professional learning committee, collaborative planning, on-going professional learning activities.

Goal 4 : STEM- has been a challenge with all the COVID guidelines. Recertification process has been pushed to next school year.
