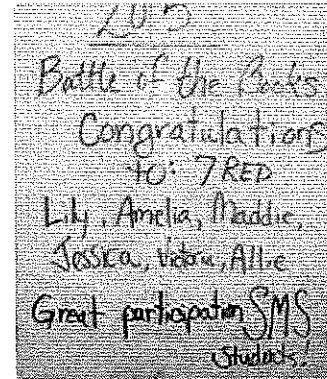
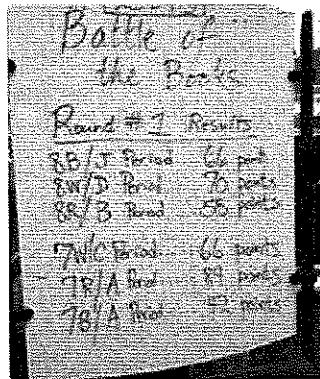
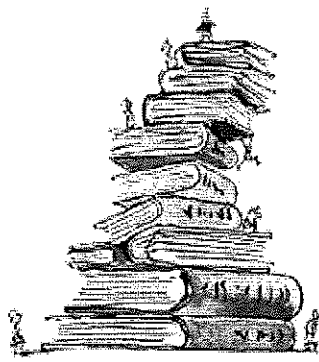


The Battle of the Books

What you need to know about The Battle of the Books!

General Information about The Battle of the Books

The Battle of the Books is a schoolwide reading competition. Students will read books from a diverse list of books, and then compete in teams to answer questions about those books. The final winner will receive a special field trip during their lunch waves!



Before the First Round of Competition..

Battle of the Books teams need to be assembled in all English classes. This is usually done during Academic Labs, or quickly at the end of class. Ideally, the students who have read the most books from the list will form a team. A team is comprised of 6 students.

First Round of Competition

Each English class creates a team of students who have read books from the list. Each English class competes against each other. This will ultimately lead to 4 winning teams from 6th grade, and 3 winning teams from 7th and 8th grade.

Final Round of Competition

The winning teams from the first round compete against each other. For example, 7 red, white, and blue all compete to make it to the final round. The final winners from this round will be crowned the grade level winner of the Battle of the Books!

More Battle of the Books Information

Copies of all of the books can be found in the LMC. There will be a "question of the week" leading up to the first round of the competition. The question will be announced during the morning announcements, and students will answer the question in the LMC during the school day. The final winners from 6th, 7th, and 8th grade will go on the final prize field trip!
