Applicant Requirements and Selection Guidelines

The St. George Rotary Club will award its annual scholarships to a senior from Woodland High School and a senior from Dorchester Academy. These scholarships will be awarded only to active Interact students. Recipients will be asked to return to the St. George Rotary Club during the next school year to give an update on their progress. Scholarships will be awarded only if all requirements are achieved.

A weighted point system will be used to judge the following criteria for the scholarship. Avoid using any reference to your name, as we judge these applications anonymously.

1. Academics: Your most recent four-year high school transcript will be reviewed for grade point average, SAT scores, ACT scores and class rank. Your name will be blacked out on these records and a code will be assigned, as we judge these applications anonymously. (25%)
2. Essay: On a separate sheet of paper, type a minimum of 200 words expressing your personal goals and how higher education will help you achieve them. Also, include in your essay how you will incorporate Rotary's current international theme in achieving your endeavors. (20%)
3. Interact programs or projects: What interact programs or projects have you actively participated in and briefly describe. (25%)
4. Extra-Curricular Activities: Membership in service clubs, varsity and intramural sports, band, student government and school projects. In addition, community involvement, church groups, scouting, etc. will be considered favorably. Please include offices held and special honors received, as they apply. (10%)
5. Other interests or hobbies outside of school. (10%)
6. Work experience: Summer or part-time jobs, with hours worked and scope of work should be included. (10%)
7. Application deadline is May 15, 2020. No applications will be accepted after this date.
