

What is the New Hampshire Dual Admission Program?

Starting in the Fall of 2015, take advantage of a new educational pathway that allows you to enroll at one of the seven New Hampshire Community Colleges and be admitted into the University System of New Hampshire at the same time.

First you'll complete an associate degree at the community college, and then transition to one of the University System of New Hampshire's institutions to complete a bachelor's degree. Along the way, you will receive special academic advising and enjoy activities at two colleges.

Why Dual Admission?

Pay one application fee and take advantage of an affordable educational pathway. Earn credits that apply to both your associate and bachelor's degrees.

You will also be able to take advantage of activities at two colleges, that may include academic, athletic, cultural and social events.

How Do I Get Started?

- 1 Visit dualnh.com and select the community college that interests you.
- 2 Apply to one of New Hampshire's Community Colleges and indicate on the application that you would like to enroll in the Dual Admission Program.
- 3 Upon acceptance into the program, and completion of placement testing, meet with a community college advisor to learn more.
- 4 Sign a Dual Admission Program contract that outlines the program requirements.
- 5 Receive your acceptance letter into the Dual Admission Program.
