The Fannin County Board of Education met in a work session with the following members present: Terry Bramlett, Chairperson; Bobby Bearden, Vice-Chairperson; Lewis DeWeese; Junior Farmer; and Emily Dunn. All members present.

Ben Arp, North GA RESA Youth Apprenticeship Coordinator, presented board members with certificates of achievement for their outstanding contributions and partnership to Fannin County High School Students. Mr. Arp stated 17 students participated in the youth apprenticeship program in school year 2008-2009 and 23 students have signed up for the program for school year 2009-2010.
