

West Clay Elementary Registration

Registration will take place July 21st- July 24th from 8:30-3:00.

Parents can pick up a registration packet and return it. We will meet you at the door to give out and pick up packets. If an adult must enter the building, only one person may enter, and a mask must be worn.

For this year, if your address is the same as last year, you do not have to show two proofs of residency. If your child is a new student or you have moved, we will need two proofs of residency.

When you register, you will select whether your child will participate in distance learning or traditional learning in school.

Traditional Learning at West Clay

We will continue to try to follow the CDC guidelines for schools. As their recommendations change, we will adjust with our procedures. We will all need to be flexible during this time. Our requirements may become more strict or lenient as the year continues. Our priority will continue to be the safety of our students.

Mornings

Every student's temperature will be checked as they enter the building. Students who have a temperature of 100.4 or more will not be allowed to stay at school. Parents are encouraged to check your child's temperature before leaving home.

Masks

Students will be required to have a face covering at school. There will be areas and times where masks must be worn.

Classroom Instruction

We will continue to use best practices for teaching and learning while following CDC recommendations.

We will continue to have Special Subjects, Speech and Gifted classes.

If school closure occurs, all students will participate in distance learning.

Distance Learning at West Clay

Below are the expectations of students and parents for distance learning.

Distance learning includes online instruction provided by teachers through videos, digital curriculum, and software programs.

Student Expectations

- Attend distance learning training session(s).
- Assignments will be graded for accuracy.
- Let teachers know when they do not understand.
- Students will monitor their grades via Canvas and Active student on a weekly basis.
- Check email daily and communicate with teacher via email, message on Canvas, and Zoom.
- Participate and complete all activities, assignments, and assessments.
- Students will be assigned a mandatory login time for assessments and other graded assignments as identified.
- Download Canvas Student app to receive announcements and reminders of assignments and for tracking progress of students' work.

Parent Expectations

- Attend distance learning training session(s).
- Parents will have an opportunity to change their child's learning option the week of August 31-September 4, 2020.
- Understand that students will not be able to be removed from distance learning after September 7, 2020.
- Stress the importance of integrity with students.
- Encourage students to attend all Zoom meetings, complete and submit all assignments on time, and complete all work with integrity.
- Download Canvas Parent app for tracking progress of student's work.
- Provide reliable internet service and device other than a cell phone to begin distance learning. The district is in the process of purchasing a device for every student, but we cannot guarantee when they will arrive.
