FAITH FORMATION RESUMES IN SEPTEMBER: Tentative date for first class of 2020-2021 Faith Formation Classes is **Wednesday, September 16th**. After discussion with our volunteer catechists and parents of students, (many we have not seen in attendance at weekend Masses) we are making adjustments to hold class each week but alternating in-person / virtual instruction. One week will be in the classroom and the following week an on-line assignment will be given and expected to be completed at home under parent assistance or review. The program we have reviewed for textbooks will have a digital component as well. It will be necessary that families make a commitment to have their children/teens attend class or virtually participate in our parish school of religion. The ability to view Holy Mass at home is not the full, active and conscious participation we are called to as catholic Christians. Using stories of scripture, church history, lives of the saints and prayer will enhance the understanding of the faith. We have willing adult leaders who will follow all precautions for themselves and our students regarding health and safety issues as they guide students in Christ.

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION: The purchase of materials will begin shortly and it is very important that **Registration Forms** and the **\$25 fee** be completed for each student (including 9 - 12 grade) and returned as soon as possible. You will find registration forms on our parish website or in the narthex. Notify the church office if you would like one mailed to you. Happily, the school building has been sanitized, organized and prepared to allow safe distancing while in the building. More specific details of the school year and guidelines will be forthcoming. 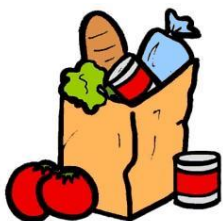


SVDP MEETING: While we will still be ministering to those in need we will not have a formal meeting until we are given the all clear by the Bishop.
