- Students with class on the first floor will enter through the District Office doors.
- Students with class on the 2nd and 3rd floors will enter through the South doors and access the stairwell..
- Students will enter the building, complete the screening process and walk directly to their first period class.
- Students will be required to sit in assigned seats to and from school.
- Please anticipate windows being open and dress appropriately

Students Being Dropped off and Picked Up:

- All student drop off and pick up will occur on the East (mountains) side of the building.
- Students with class on the 2nd and 3rd floors will enter through the main door.
- Students with class on the 1st floor will enter through the Southeast door next to the gym and access the stairwell.
- Students will not be allowed to enter the building prior to 8am.
- Students being dropped off and transporting themselves will complete the screening and walk directly to their first period class.
- Students being picked up after school will only be allowed to be picked up on the East side of the building.

Students Transporting Themselves

- All students will park in the East (mountains) parking lot.
- There is no student specific designated parking (i.e., Senior Parking)
- Parking permits are currently not required
- Students with class on the 2nd and 3rd floors will enter through the main door.
- Students with class on the 1st floor will enter through the Southeast door next to the gym and access the stairwell to the first floor.
- Students will not be allowed to enter the building prior to 8am.
- Students will complete the screening and walk directly to their first period class.

What do I need to bring to school?

Your personal bag or backpack needs to have:

- ChromeBook or personal computer w/ YOUR CHARGER
- Something to write with (pen and/or pencil)
- Your own water bottle
- Notebooks/paper as required in your classes
- Lockers are not accessible
- Suggested:
 - Paper, Spiral, or Composition Book
 - Simple calculator
 - Extra face covering
 - Personal hand sanitizer

Safety Protocols

- All students will be required to wear a FITTED mask. (No bandanas)
- Wash and sanitize hands...required to do so before and after lunch.
- Subject to visual screen upon boarding bus and entering building.
- Complete screening questionnaire in 1st period or upon arrival.
- Restrooms only accessible during class - only one student per classroom at a time.
- Strict seating arrangements in class, at lunch, and on the bus.

Sanitization

- Students will take a clean towel upon entering the room.
- At end of class, the teacher will spray down desks.
- After three minutes, students will wipe off their own area.
- Students will discard soiled towel on the way to their next class.

Students that refuse or are consistently unable to follow safety protocols will be required to access their education remotely.

Answers to Submitted Questions

- Under current guidance 18-21 students is our max based on the square footage of rooms
- Each room has an air purifier placed in the classroom
- Our HVAC system is currently using MERV 13 filters
- Students will transition to classes all at once by moving in a counterclockwise manner to their next class
- Any student can take a free school provided meal that includes breakfast items for the following morning
- Any student that needs to be isolated during the day will be removed from class and observed in an isolation room until a parent/guardian can pick the student up from school
- If there is a confirmed case, we will contact trace with the help of the LHA and determine if any students or staff must quarantine. A confirmed case does not require the entire cohort to quarantine
- Students selecting to change from CDL to Hybrid or Hybrid to CDL must notify the main office
- Campus will be closed. Students will be required to eat in designated areas
