	<p>More than one confirmed case with contact time in school during time of suspected infection.</p> <p>Cases are “epidemiologically linked”</p>	High	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of affected classrooms for 14 days All Staff and Students quarantine County to conduct extensive contact tracing Online learning begins Disinfection of entire school Measurable return to school protocols followed

*contact time= within 6ft for 15 min or more

**any school closure will mean a shift to the *SESD Distance Learning Model* implemented at the start of the school year

***This matrix is only a guide and decisions about individual and school closures will be made in conjunction with the Superintendent, School Board and Pinal County Health Department.
