1 C lemon-flavored instant tea



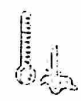
1 C orange-flavored drink mix

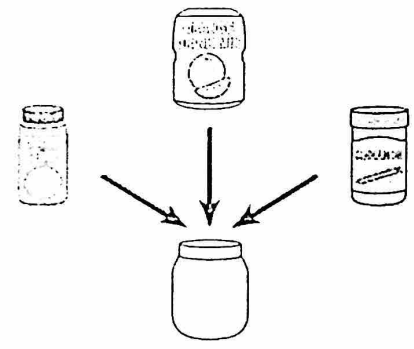

1. Put tea, drink mix and cinnamon into jar.



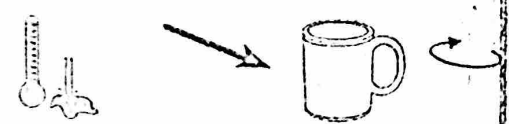

4. Put hot water into mug. Stir.



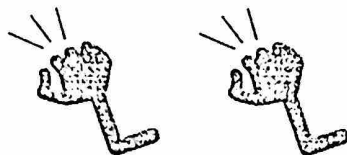
