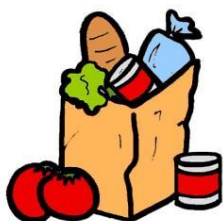


SVDP MEETING: The next meeting will be Sunday February 7th after Mass. All are welcome to attend. Mask and social distancing required.
