I. COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will encompass areas of science that deal with living things. Students will study the methods of science, biochemical processes (respiration, photosynthesis, etc.), genetics, the six kingdoms of life, human anatomy and physiology, evolution, and ecology. Major laboratories will include cell membranes and permeability, DNA model building, DNA gel electrophoresis, Karyotype simulation, computer and microscopic study of protozoa, computer guided study of the voyage of the Beagle and biomes of the world, dissection, and blood pressure measurement. During this class, students will develop skills for critical reading of scientific material and be able to draw conclusions from scientific data. They will also investigate and inquire through experimentation and will appreciate the interactions of all forms of life.

II. REQUIRED MATERIALS

A notebook with pockets to keep handouts (spiral or 3 ring binder)
A pen (blue or black ink only) or pencil
