What is Supplemental Learning?

We're committed to keeping in touch with students and ensuring they stay engaged and have opportunities to learn.

Supplemental Learning is NOT normal school. The material, resources and activities provided are intended to review, or provide extension activities, for material students have already covered. This work is meant to be at a level so students can complete it with minimal help from adults at home.

All seniors will either; be eligible for graduation under the new guidelines from the Oregon Dept. of Education and will be done with school for the year; or will be provided instructional opportunities and instructional support to complete coursework and credits to meet those new graduation requirements.

How will it be provided?

Online and in learning packets.

Online and in learning packets. Learning websites, teacher-suggested activities and other learning resources will be available on our District website. There will also be paper packets for students to work on similar material at home. Students can choose to complete either, or both. A system for delivering this work to students through bus routes and our meal distribution system is in development. More information on when and where to pick up this work will be coming soon.

Any Seniors in need of completing coursework for graduation will be contacted directly by our teaching staff. Individual plans will be developed for online and/or paper work completion to meet graduation requirements.

What if students need help?

Teachers and Counselors are just a phone call away.

Teachers, Counselors and Instructional Assistants will be able to be reached by phone or email. All teachers, Counselor and designated Instructional Assistants will be available via phone during designated hours (to be determined), or via school email.

Senior graduation will be our number one academic priority. Teachers and Counselors will be available for students via phone and email. We will be working hard to ensure the graduation of all our Seniors.

What if we need supplies?

We are delivering Chromebooks, packets, and learning materials.

We will work to provide you any school supplies that you need to complete these activities, if you don't have them. Please contact your teacher if you have needs for supplies, and we will work to get them to you on the next instructional delivery.

All efforts will be made to provide any supplies needed for a senior to complete their graduation requirements.

What about wifi?

We've worked with neighbors and friends to add wifi around town and upped wifi power in our parking lots.

We are working to provide every child with access to Google accounts for easy communication with their teacher(s).

All efforts will be made to provide any technology needed for a senior to complete their graduation requirements.

Resources for supplemental learning are not intended to replace classroom instruction or district-adopted curriculum. No content will be graded and all of these activities are optional.
