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Requirements for Distance Learning

Grade: For students to remain on the virtual learning platform, they must fall into one of the following

- 1. Students deemed "medically fragile" with a physician's order will be allowed to continue on the virtual learning platform.
 - **a.** Parents must submit signed medical excuse from the child's physician.
 - b. Students will turn in work required by the teacher to document successful progress in and mastery toward the content of the class.
 - c. Students will log into the learning management system daily to keep up with instruction presented and work assigned.
 - d. Accommodations will be made to meet the needs of all medically "fragile students."

2. Parent request based on parents perceived risk or pandemic related issues provided they are able to meet the following required provisions:

- a. Strict adherence to the schedule (5 days per week) on the virtual platform.
- b. Parents will be required to provide a device per child and adequate internet until such time as the district is able to provide a device for distance learning.
- c. Students will "log into" their learning management system account each day.
- d. Attendance will be taken each day one of two ways:
 - i. Students will log on to live classroom sessions and will be seen by their teacher to be counted present. Students will be required to be fully present and engaged at all times when there is an online instructional meet session.
 - ii. Students will also log into the learning management platform, Schoology, to view instructional videos and complete daily assignments.
- e. Parents will be responsible for transportation of virtual students to the school for proctored assessments as scheduled each week/month.
- f. Students participating in virtual learning must complete a 9-week session before choosing to change to the hybrid/traditional in-person schedule.
- g. Distance Learning / Virtual students will be held to the same expectation for work submission and grading guidelines as traditional in-person students.
- h. Students on a full virtual schedule will not be allowed to participate in sports or extracurricular activities.
