

6th grade Supply List:

All students need to purchase a **zipper pouch** with the following items:

- Colored pencils, markers, highlighters **or** crayons
- A pair of scissors
- A glue stick

Every day, you need to take these art supply zipper pouches to Science and Social Studies only. The rest of the day, **they may remain in your lockers.** Your other teachers will let you know when you need to bring art supplies to their classes.

The following supplies will be dropped off in your **first period class**:

- **BOYS ONLY:** 1 roll paper towels, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, 1 box of Kleenex, 1 container of Clorox wipes
 - **GIRLS ONLY:** 1 pkg. Post-It notes (any size or color), 1 pkg. of Ticonderoga wooden pencils, 1 pkg. cap erasers, 1 pkg. dry erase markers

ELA supplies:

- 2 pkgs. wide-ruled notebook paper (You will put one in your binder and give the other to your ELA teacher.)
- 1 Package of dividers
- 2 composition books (not spiral)
- Pencils (We recommend wooden pencils, but if you use mechanical, be sure to have extra lead, if needed.)

Math supplies:

- 1 binder (2-inch or larger)
- 1 basic (4-function) calculator (\$1)
- 4-pack (or larger) pkg. of dry erase markers (Your math teacher will keep these in her room.)
- A 3-hole zipper pouch kept in your math binder (This will hold your calculator and pencils.)

Science supplies:

- 1 “5-Star” 3-subject spiral notebook with storage pockets
- 1 pkg. lined index cards (Your science teacher will collect these and keep them in her room.)

Social Studies supplies:

- 1 “5-Star” 3-subject spiral notebook with storage pockets
