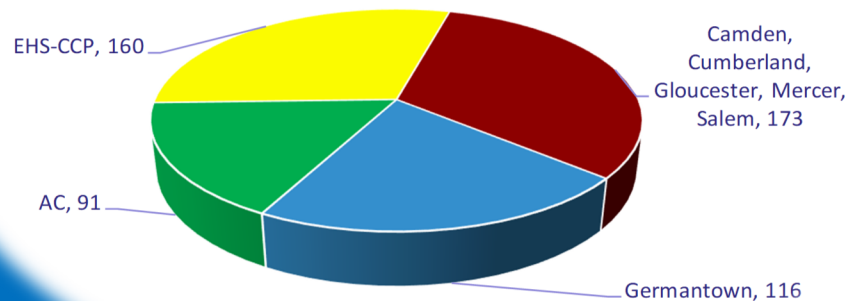
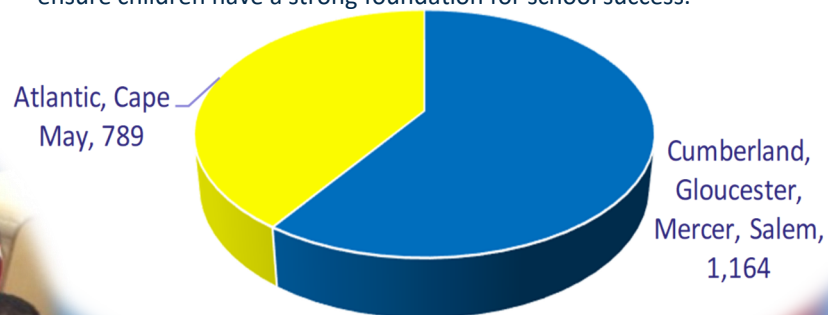


540 Infants, Toddlers and Pregnant Women served in Early Head Start with an average of 477 enrolled throughout the year. Serving approximately 3% of children living in the Gateway service area.



1953 Preschool-aged children served in Head Start with an average of 1780 enrolled throughout the year. Serving approximately 18% of children living in the Gateway service area. Gateway coordinates with several of the school district preschools and child care centers in the service area to ensure children have a strong foundation for school success.



1,623 children received physical exams and 1,334 children received dental exams

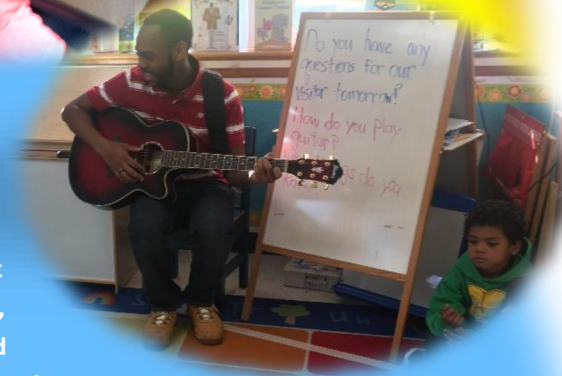
Gateway completed the Focus Area One Aligned Monitoring Review in November 2018.

Fathers and other male role models participated in their child’s Early Head Start and Head Start experience. They shared skills such as playing the guitar, attended male oriented community meetings, worked with the Male Involvement Coordinator to meet goals, read to their child, became involved in classroom activities and attended special events with their child. Altogether,

2,820 parents and former parents volunteered, participating in school activities as well as supporting their child’s education from home.
