John Leflore High School formerly known as Leflore High School of Communication and Arts opened its doors in 1981 with both a comprehensive high school and magnet high school component. It offers an innovative program through accelerated academic courses providing opportunistic challenges and career explorations for its students.

The advanced studies component emphasizes a combination of Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment courses in the areas of English, Social Studies, Mathematics, and Science. In addition to the required core courses, students study two (2) years of foreign languages, leadership, and a variety of electives in communications, the arts, photography, computer technology, and journalism. We also have a Signature Academy of Law and Public Safety, Arts, Business and Computer Technology, and Health Services, with a fully functioning community health clinic, photography studio, dance studio, and court room. Our academy provides our students with the opportunity to gain exposure to a variety of careers, engage in real world application of learning and rigorous yet relevant instruction both inside and outside of the classroom.

Students who are outside of Leflore's attendance zone must complete a Signature Academy application prior to admission in order to be considered for the academy of their interest.

Leflore High School prides itself on the successful and notable alums who have matriculated through Leflore over the years. Alums such as our very own Mobile County Superintendent Mr. Chresal Threadgill who was sworn in as Mobile County's first black superintendent. We have many other distinguished professionals such as Dr. Carey McDade Hancock and Dr. Henry J. Henderson who still serve, work and give back to our community. Our rich alumni range from educators, clergy, lawyers, medical professionals, entrepreneurs and business owners like Erica Barrett, founder of Southern Culture Foods, owner of the popular SOCU restaurant located in historic downtown Mobile, and whose products have been featured on the Oprah Network. Also a very notable alum, Ms. Sherry McDade who taught at Leflore and in the community for 37 years, is now serving as our District 4 School Board Representative. Our students have worked very hard to overcome the many challenges associated with the COVID pandemic, virtual learning, and a very active hurricane season. LHS MAGNET PROGRAM: AN ACADEMY OF CHOICE

LeFlore Magnet High School of Law, Arts, and Health Services is a college and career bound program providing students with academic opportunities. LeFlore is a school with programs that follow established guidelines offering comprehensive, honors, and advanced placement classes. Students enrolled at LeFlore complete a four- year academic plan that will lead to a Regular High School Diploma or an Advanced Diploma with Honors. The advanced studies component of LeFlore emphasizes advanced courses in Art, English, Foreign Language, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies. In addition to required core courses, a wide variety of electives are available for students to take that focus in areas including: Broadcasting, Business Marketing, Photography, Pre-Medicine, Theatre and much more. Students needing extra instructional support will be offered after school tutoring.
