#### Communication Folder:

A plastic folder will be provided for students on the first day of school. Students will keep study guides, login information, homework, etc. within this folder. The folder will be taken home each day and returned to school the following day. Having their folder with them is part of their classroom expectations. Please check your child's folders every night for important things, such as signed papers, etc.

#### **Behavior Expectations:**

We have high expectations for the students in our rooms. We expect the students to achieve academically to their fullest potential. 
