Dear parishioners,

This Friday we celebrate the memorial of Blessed Michael McGivney, who along with Blessed Solanus (July 30) and Blessed Stanley Rother (July 28), has the potential of being the first natural born man from the United States to be canonized. He does not have an immediate connection to our diocese (Fr. Greg Schaefer worked with Bl. Stanley in their respective neighboring missions, and Bl. Solanus's brother served in Graceville), Blessed Michael has had perhaps a stronger influence as the founder of the Knights of Columbus. He saw the need to help provide for the widows and orphans when their husbands and fathers were taken too soon without providing for their future, as well as the need for a Catholic Fraternity (many were considering going to the Anti-Catholic Masons). The KCs were born, and there are councils in almost every Area Faith Community of our Diocese.

Blessed Michael died on August 14, 1890, at the age of 38, having been a priest 13 years. He had to take a leave from seminary to help his family when his father died. Perhaps this was the impetus that led him to be concerned with the widows and orphans. For more information on him, see the official website for his canonization https://www.fathermegivney.org/.

On Saturday, we celebrate the memorial of St. Maximilian Kolbe, a Polish Franciscan Priest, who was killed by the Nazi's in Auschwitz after he took the place of a father who was randomly picked as 1 of 10 to be punished for the escape of a fellow prisoner. Because of Fr. Maximilian's encouragement, the other nine lived longer than expected and died praying and praising the Lord. He eventually was killed by an injection of carbolic acid. His remains were cremated. He had a tremendous love of the Blessed Mother, and so it is fitting that his feast is the eve of the Assumption.

Next Weekend is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Mother. It is a Holy Day of Obligation every year except when it falls on Saturday or Monday (and all Sundays are obligatory again). Please come ready to praise God for Blessed Mother's entrance into Eternity.
