1) NAGE Scholarship - \$500 - 100 Awards (Deadline: May 18, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be planning to attend or already be attending a two or four-year college, graduate school, trade or technical school to be eligible.
- B) Be a member of NAGE, IBPO, IBCO, or IAEP, or be the member's spouse, child, grandchild, niece, nephew, or significant other.

2) Brower Youth Award Scholarships - \$3,000 - 6 Awards (Deadline: May 20, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be youth environmental change leaders between the ages of 13 to 22 (as of July 1, 2018) living in North America (including Mexico, Canada, some Caribbean Islands) and US "Territories".

3) WaterLogic Scholarship - \$1,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: May 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a student enrolled in college or with an expected college enrollment date up to 12 months in the future.
- B) Be a resident of the United States.

4) SP Scholarships - \$10,000 – 10 Awards (Deadline: May 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) At least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) A legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

5) American Indian College Fund Scholarships - \$1,000 - 100 Awards (Deadline: May 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a U.S. citizen eligible to attend college in the U.S.
- B) Be enrolled in a certificate, associates, bachelors, or graduate program by the Fall of 2018.

6) Harris Poll Scholarships - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: May 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a legal resident of the 50 United States.
- B) Be 13 years or older at the time of entry,

7) LM Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: May 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

1. Be currently enrolled or expect to be enrolled in a degree program (2 years of length or greater) by September 2018.
2. Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and submit an answer to the essay question prior to the submission deadline.

- A) Be a high school student in Grades 9, 10, 11, or 12.

- A) Be a female high school student in Grades 11 or 12.

- B) Participate in a state level competition.
