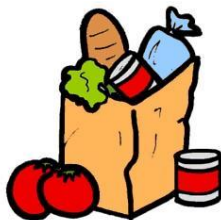

Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time: In the Gospel today Jesus says: "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God."
