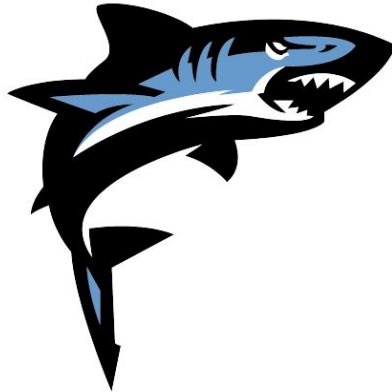

# Transportation & Drop Off

- All students riding the bus will enter through the NW flex space doors.
- Students will enter the building, complete the screening process and walk directly to their first period class.
- Students riding the bus from school will exit out of the same door they entered and walk directly to their bus to load.
- Students will be required to sit in assigned seats to and from school.
- Please anticipate windows being open and dress appropriately

Students Being Dropped off and Picked Up:

- All student drop off and pick up will occur on the West side of the building.
- Students will be directed to enter through a gymnasium door or through a hallway door between the gym and main door.
- Students will not be allowed to enter the building prior to 8am.
- Students being dropped off will complete the screening and walk directly to their first period class down the stairs immediately outside of the gym.
- Students being picked up after school will only be allowed to be picked up on the west side of the building.

# What do I need to bring to school?

Your personal bag or backpack needs to have:

- ChromeBook or personal computer w/  
YOUR CHARGER
- Something to write with (pen and/or pencil)
- Your own water bottle
- Suggested:
  - Paper, Spiral, or Composition Book
  - Simple calculator
  - Extra face covering
  - Personal hand sanitizer

What's the deal with cell phones?

- Students may bring them to school.
- Must be silenced and remain in backpack/bag during class.
- May NOT use them in class as alternative to ChromeBook or computer.
- Students will be able to use them during their lunch period.
- Misuse of cell phones will result in phones being taken away and parents needing to pick them up.

# Safety Protocols

- All students will be required to wear a FITTED mask. (No bandanas)
- Wash and sanitize hands...required to do so before and after lunch.
- Subject to visual screen upon boarding bus and entering building.
- Complete screening questionnaire in 1st period or upon arrival.
- Restrooms only accessible during class - only one student per classroom at a time.
- Strict seating arrangements in class, at lunch, and on the bus.

## Sanitization

- Students will take a clean towel upon entering the room.
- At end of class, the teacher will spray down desks.
- After three minutes, students will wipe off their own area.
- Students will discard soiled towel on the way to their next class.

Students that refuse or are consistently unable to follow safety protocols will be required to access their education remotely.

# Answers to Submitted Questions

- 18 students is our max based on the square footage of rooms
- Each room has an air purifier placed in the classroom
- Our HVAC system is currently using MERV 8 filters and will be upgraded to MERV 13
- Students will transition to classes all at once by moving in a counterclockwise manner to their next class
- Students will have assigned seats in the middle school gym for lunch
- Any student can take a free school provided meal that includes breakfast items for the following morning
- Any student that needs to be isolated during the day will be removed from class and observed in an isolation room until a parent/guardian can pick the student up from school
- If there is a confirmed case, we will contact trace with the help of the LHA and determine if any students or staff must quarantine. A confirmed case does not require the entire cohort to quarantine
