Pat Foust introduced Ms. Wall, a teacher at Grays Chapel Elementary. Students from Grays Chapel were recognized for winning first, second, and third place as the Piedmont Winners for the Yearlong Stock Market Game.

Debbie Johns from Southwestern Randolph High School introduced students who have been a part of the teacher cadet program. Ms. Johns stated that 137 cadets have gone through the program of which 110 are teachers or currently enrolled in an educational program at a university. There have been 25 teaching fellows from the program and a total of \$650,000 in scholarships.

Wheatmore Curriculum

Kim Johnson, 9-12 Instruction Director, and Ann Callicutt, Career-Technical Director gave an update from the Forum held at Trinity High School where approximately 150 people were in attendance. The Task Force recommendation to the Board of Education is Residential Plus which is a duplication of some programs and some specialized programs only at one school site. Attendance lines tell students where to go to school; Programs are duplicated as dictated by student registration; specialized programs may become limited; specialized academies might be located only on one site (ex. JROTC, Advanced Placement Courses). In addition to the Task Force recommendations, we hope to continue to explore additional course offerings at both campuses (ex. Automotive Service Technology, Culinary Arts, etc.)

EC Indicators

Carol VonCannon, EC Director, reviewed the CIPP (Continuous Improvement Performance Plan) and the fifteen EC indicators.

School Choice/Watch List

Cathy Brady, K-5 Director, presented information for the 2008-2009 school of choice. There are currently four on the watch list – Level Cross, Liberty, Randleman Elementary, and Tabernacle. Ramseur Elementary and Southmont Elementary will offer school choice as part of the two year requirement. Thirteen out of the 17 elementary schools are Title 1 funded.

Asthma Awareness Month

Tember Blevins, school nurse, presented information on a new program beginning during the month of May by monitoring ozone levels in the air and flying colored flags based on the conditions of the air quality. The flags will be flown at all county schools to keep students, parents, teachers and the community at-large aware of air quality. This will help schools as well as the community to plan day to day activities.

Attendance Lines A-T Update

Superintendent Andrews updated the board that there are three scenarios that the A-T Board members along with transportation are continuing to review. Once they are finalized there will be a time for public comments and then brought to the Board of Education for approval.

Child Nutrition Meal Prices

Donna Osborne, Child Nutrition Director, presented information to request price increases for the 2008-2009 school year. The last meal price increase was in 2000-2001. Ms. Osborne expressed she takes meal prices very seriously especially within a difficult economy for parents, and would like to avoid requesting significant increases every few years. A change in prices now would prevent significant losses to our program and would be feasible for our parents.

NCSBA Directors Update

Becky Coltrane, Vice Chair, and who serves on the NCSBA Board of Directors reviewed guidelines to develop for school boards across the state. Vision, standards for students and staff, assessments, accountability measures, resources aligned with needs and goals for the school system, and a positive learning environment in collaboration between communities for continual improvements. Ms. Coltrane asked the board members to think about qualifications and ethical areas they would like to meet and respond to as leaders in the community and our schools.

Facility Planning and Construction Updates

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations reported that Fran Andrews, Mayor of Trinity has requested permission to place a Civil War Trails Marker on the property of Braxton Craven along the drive heading towards the stop light near the gazebo. Fran Andrews has secured funding for the marker. We have reviewed this request, consulted with the principal and found no problems with this request.

B. Coltrane made a motion seconded by J. Johnson to allow the marker to be placed on the property of Braxton Craven near the gazebo. The motion carried: 7-0

An update was given on the high schools gym air conditioning projects – Bids were opened on May 15<sup>th</sup>. Three individual bids were received for Southwest and Trinity and only two bids for Eastern. The bids were extremely high. Due to the high bids and not enough bids for Eastern, all bids were rejected. The new date for opening bids will be June 12 and presented to the board at the June 16 board meeting. The three schools will be combined as one project. This will hopefully help with the cost.

Mr. Trotter reported information he received in a conference call he had with representatives from Guilford County Schools on April 22, 2008 concerning ideas and input in opening a new school after the school year has started.

Report on Wheatmore High School

Mr. Trotter reported that steel continues to go up, electrical plumbing and mechanical work continues, in the process of getting prices to add fence and gates to the property, meeting with NCDOT to discuss final plans of the road widening project on May 28 – additional Right of Ways must be obtained.

Report on Providence Grove High School

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations reported that the final paving is taking place, and extra security is in place. The first walk through will be June 2. The building is scheduled to be turned over on or around June 23. Rick Dawes, Principal reported he had completed his first faculty meeting, three coaches have been hired for volley ball, baseball, track and cross country. Rick Dawes is in the process of meeting with Coke vendor and there is a possibility of them paying for part of the sprinkler system for the fields.
