

Regular Session
January 18, 2005

The Randolph County Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, January 18, 2005, at 6 p.m. in Board Room B at the Central Office.

Call to Order

Chairman LaVerne Williams called the meeting to order. Board members in attendance were as follows: P. Guthrie, G. Cook, T. McDonald, G. Lawson, J. Johnson, and B. Coltrane.

Moment of Silence

The Board observed a Moment of Silence before beginning the meeting.

Pledge of Allegiance

Trinity High School JROTC led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Recognition of Guests

Adoption of Agenda

G. Lawson made a motion seconded by T. McDonald that the Board adopt the agenda as presented. The motion carried: 7-0.

Consent Items

P. Guthrie made a motion seconded by B. Coltrane that the Board approve consent items as presented:

1. Assignments and Releases – 18 assignments, 1 releases, and 0 denial for the 2004-2005 school year.
2. Attorney Bob Wilhoit asked that the Board approve settlement of a \$50,000 bond forfeiture with a \$10,000 down payment and \$5,000 to be paid each month on the balance due with Bail America Surety Inc./Allegheny Mutual Insurance Company and Andrew Blizzard, Bondsman and Cole Surety.
3. First Reading of Policies – 1710/4021/7230 Prohibition Against Discrimination, Harassment, and Bulling; 4120 Domicile or Residence Requirements; and 4300 Trespassing (Part of Code of Student Conduct).

The motion carried: 7-0.

Title I Program

Linda Bassetti, Executive Director of Elementary Education, described the Title I Program, funding, and its role in No Child Left Behind. Randolph County has 13 schools funded through Title I providing programs

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for low-income, at-risk children. A Title I Plan is written annually and focuses on reading in Randolph County. She explained the No Child Left Behind Act and what determines AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress).

Budget Subcommittees and Meeting Date

Chairperson Williams appointed the following budget subcommittees: Current Expense - Becky Coltrane, Chair; Paul Guthrie, and Janet Johnson and Capital Outlay – Tommy McDonald, Chair; Grady Lawson and Gary Cook. The Board will meet in special session on Monday, February 28, 2005 at 6 p.m. to review budget requests and begin developing the 2006-2007 proposed budget.

High School Facilities Update

Superintendent Bob McRae expressed appreciation to the Randolph County Board of Commissioners for their support by adopting the COPS method of funding high school construction projects. Executive Director of Construction and Facilities Bob Scherer, reported that a proposed site had been located for the Northeastern Randolph High School project and that testing of soil and design of the facility had begun. He reported that a suitable site for a high school should contain 60 acres of useable property. He presented the Board with a packet of information outlined a proposed schedule and projects cost estimates for construction of Northeastern Randolph High School. The COPS funding will also include funds for a new high school in the Archdale-Trinity Area. A search will begin soon for a realtor, architect, and land for this project.
