Grade 5 (Patterson) and Grade 6 (Kekel)

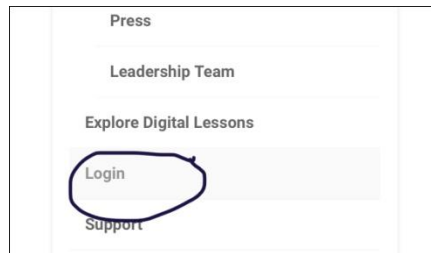

(In 5th grade the following students have a different number and they are: wyatt, aurora and hannah. Your number is 26first name.last name)

Here are some common mistakes: if your name is Joe you need to type in your full name such as Joseph. Sometimes you put the period after the number - wrong. It should be placed after the first name and don't use spaces or capitals.
