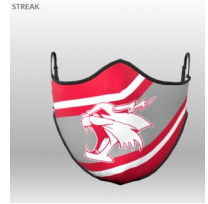

# Update on Mask Requirement in K-12 Schools From the AZ Department of Education



We wanted to share information we received from the Arizona Department of Health Services in light of Governor Ducey's executive order relaxing COVID-19 restrictions. [AZDHS Emergency Measure 2020-04](#) is still in effect, requiring masks in all K-12 schools. Masking is one of the top mitigation strategies for safe in-person learning as [recommended](#) by the CDC.

**Masks must be worn on school campuses, on school buses and during school-associated activities by all students, faculty, staff, contractors, and visitors.**

As we reopen school full time, at home daily health screenings are more important than ever. If your student exhibits any of the following symptoms, please do not send him/her to school. Please help us keep school open!

At home daily health screenings

Students must not come to school if they exhibit any of the following symptoms

- \* Fever
- \* Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- \* Cough
- \* Fatigue
- \* Headache
- \* Muscle or body aches
- \* Sore throat
- \* Congestion/runny nose
- \* Nausea/vomiting
- \* Diarrhea
- \* New loss of taste or smell





## 2021-2022 REGISTRATION

Registration for next year is ONLINE. All 7th grade students were sent home with instructions on how to complete the online process and are also included in this newsletter. Students entering high school are also asked to complete the online process. This includes current PLP students.

### **The deadline to complete your online registration is April 16th.**

All 7th AND 8th graders were sent home with a health form that must be completed and returned to our office. We must receive a hard copy of the health form from every student. If a 7th grade student requires bussing next year, a new registration form must also be completed.

If you do not complete the online process, a paper packet will be required. If you do not have access to a computer, you may use one in our lobby or request a paper packet. All students must provide proof of AZ residency. Instructions are included on how to upload a document. Other options are to bring in a hard copy or email [susan.blanchard@lhusd.org](mailto:susan.blanchard@lhusd.org).

Please note the following when providing a document for AZ residency.

- ◆ The document must match the name of a parent or legal guardian.
- ◆ The document must match your current address (no PO box)
- ◆ The document must include the entire statement, not just the front of an envelope.
- ◆ Insurance or medical bills are not acceptable.
- ◆ Please follow the guidelines on the Arizona Residency Documentation Form.

If your child will NOT be attending Thunderbolt or LHHS next year, please notify the office.

## DIRECT LINE TO ATTENDANCE IS 854-7277

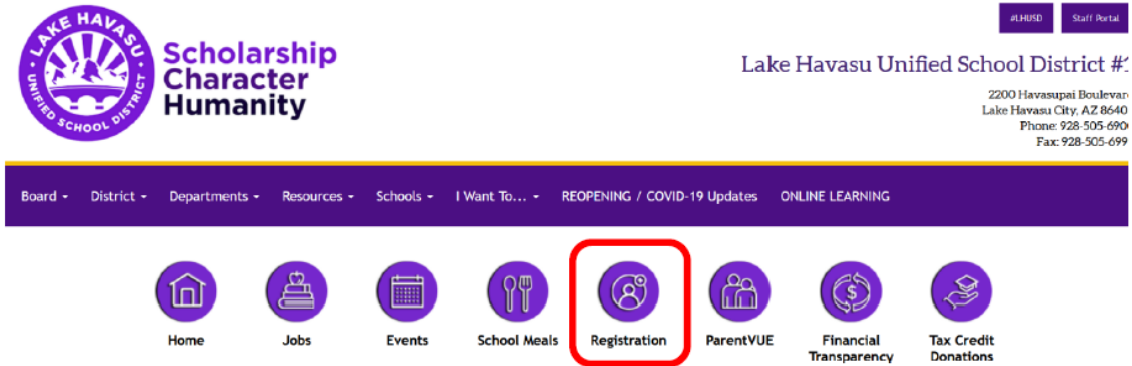
If your student is later than 15 minutes to school in the morning, please walk in to sign him/her in, call to excuse the tardy, or send in a note. At this time, the absence will be counted as a full class period and not counted as a tardy. The first period class will show as an unexcused absence and will have to be explained by a parent or guardian.

The direct line to our Attendance Office is 854-7277. A message can be left on this number 24/7. Any time your student is absent or tardy to school we must receive an excuse. To avoid receiving an automated phone call from our calling system, please excuse the absence before 9:30 a.m. You may also call in advance if you know of a future absence or you may leave a message after hours.

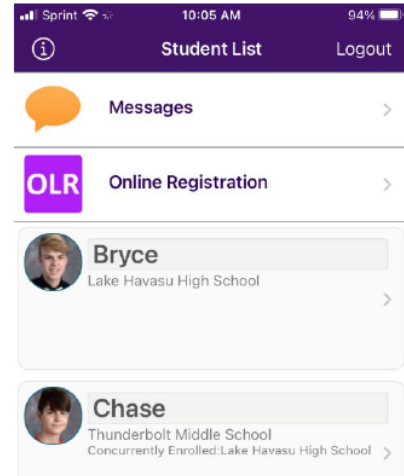
### Online Registration Account Access
